Is my gift tax deductible?

Yes. For those who itemize their deductions, contributions to N.S.C.A.R. are tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law. N.S.C.A.R. is a 510(c)(3) educational organization. Check with your financial consultant, tax attorney or accountant for tax advice pertaining to gifts to N.S.C.A.R.
